This **diversity** characterizes its population, **native and immigrant**, latinamerican, european and asian, who knows hospitality and courtesy despite being among the twenty most populated in the world. Its expression is the architectural eclecticism of the **hundred neighborhoods (“barrios”)** of the city: from the little and colorful Italian-fashioned houses in **La Boca**, to the **Museum Mile**, with avenues of Madrid style and Parisian palaces.






Museo Nacional de Bellas Artes




Social life




